

- 1. This \$5000 post high school scholarship will be presented by the **Walsh Family CAVC Scholarship Foundation** annually.
- 2. The student must maintain and verify a cumulative grade point average of at least 2.5 on a 4.0 scale or equivalent.
- 3. The student must be a full time high school senior or full time college student at an accredited vocational school, accredited business college, junior college, four year college or graduate school.
- 4. The student must be an American citizen, a California resident, and be sponsored by a CAVC member company.
- 5. Family income or college major are not determinants.
- 6. \$2500 of the scholarship will be forwarded in the student's name to the college of choice, prior to registration, for classes in the Fall semester. The second \$2500 will be forwarded to the college, prior to registration, for the second semester upon verification that the recipient has maintained a cumulative grade point average of at least a 2.0 on a 4.0 scale in the first semester.
- 7. The scholarship is good only for the academic year in which it is awarded and will be forfeited if the student does not attend school beginning in the Fall semester.
- 8. Applicants may reapply each year for as long as they are eligible. (An applicant may only win once).
- 9. Every CAVC member company whose dues are paid in full may submit two applicants. Member companies who wish to submit additional applicants may submit one additional name for each \$350 donation to the Scholarship Foundation fund.
- 10. Every CAVC member company shall be responsible for abiding by the Foundation rules when screening and submitting potential candidates.
- 11. Each applicant must fill out this application and each CAVC member company shall submit its choices annually. Applications must be postmarked by the **DEADLINE** date of **April 15, 2016**
- 12. The names of all qualified applicants will be placed in a box and winners drawn by lot at the CAVC Board of Directors Meeting held in April.
- 13. The Walsh Family CAVC Scholarship Foundation Board of Directors shall meet prior to the drawing and determine the number of scholarships to be given that year.
