

tor and Industry consultant. Educated at the University of Southern California, Brad has a Bachelor of Science degree in Marketing and an MBA in Finance and Business Economics.



### Congresswoman Marth McSally

Congresswoman Martha McSally proudly represents the people of Arizona's Second Congressional District in the U.S. House of Representatives, where she serves on the Committees on Armed Services and Homeland Security and as the chair of the Subcommittee on Border and Maritime Security.
